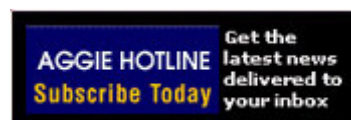
Capraro Appointed To National Middle School Association Research Board

Robert Capraro, assistant professor of mathematics education in the Department of Teaching, Learning and Culture at Texas A&M University, was appointed to the National Middle School Association Research Advisory (NMSA) Board for a three-year term.
